Graduation Expectations

Graduation expectations are the abilities or skills that our students will successfully demonstrate before they graduate. These outcomes will enable our students to effectively meet the challenges they will face as lifelong learners in an increasingly complex and changing world. Students graduating from Allegan Public Schools will demonstrate:

- A basic understanding of technology and the ability to apply it.
- Competency in effective critical thinking, problem solving, and decision making in an age of change.
- Appreciation for creative expression and diverse artistic and cultural achievement.
- Effective communication.
- Proficiency in life management skills.
- Basic personal/interpersonal skills.

Points of Pride:

- The APS Performing Arts Center was host to the entertaining musical productions **Scrooge** and **A Broadway Revue**, as well as **Charlotte's Web**, all performed by talented high school students.
- The **Allegan Tigershark Aquatic Club** continues to grow, and this year we formed our first ever high school men's swim team.
- At Allegan High School, 103 students from the Class of 2007 (53% of those tested) will receive the Michigan Promise Scholarship for their demonstrated proficiency in all four areas of the MEAP.
- The **Kid's Hope** mentoring Program is currently implemented in all four of our elementary schools, and the middle school implemented a **Safe Futures** mentoring and after-school program.

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

Allegan High School offers Advanced Placement courses in the following subjects: biology, physics, chemistry, calculus, French, Spanish, English, U.S. history, world history, European History, and U.S. government. Students can receive college credit with successful scoring on a written AP exam.
