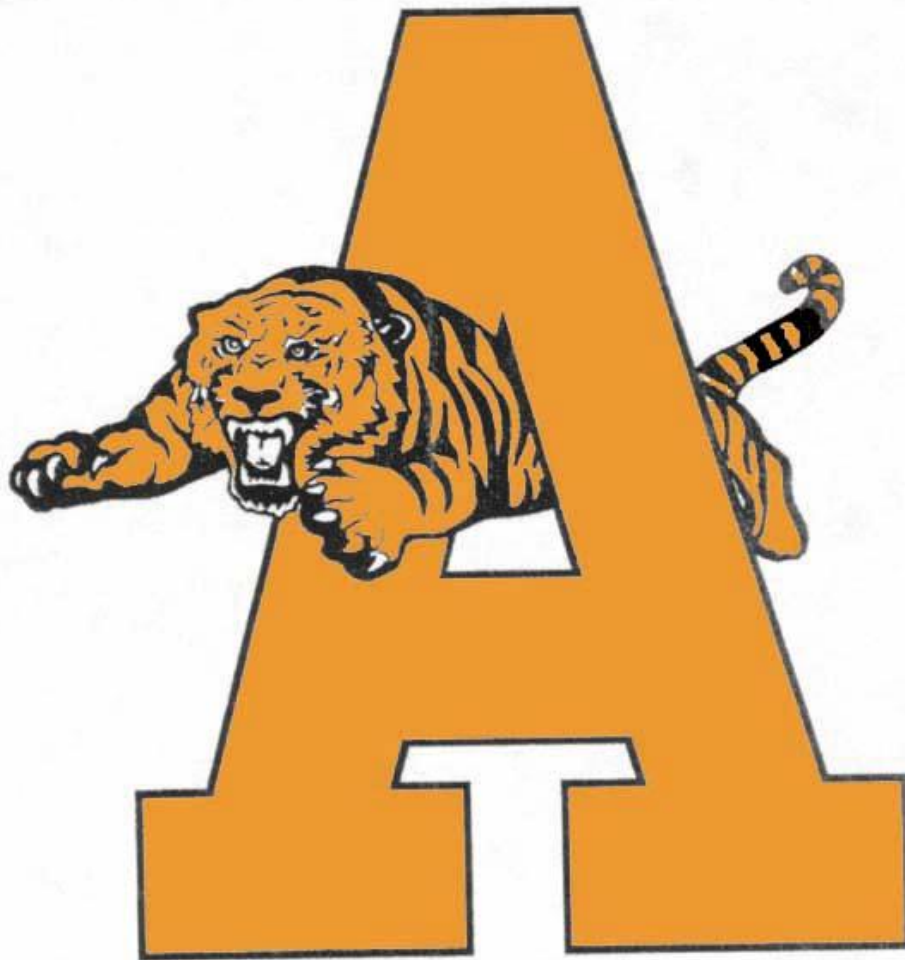

## HALL OF FAME - CLASS OF 2011

The Booster Club inducted its fourteenth class into the Allegan High School Athletic Hall of Fame on May 21.
